

PRIVACY POLICY

1 GENERAL

- 1.1 This privacy policy ("**Privacy Policy**"), describes how PowerTender AB, corporate registration number 559072-8118, with its principal place of business at Storgatan 14, SE-771 30 Ludvika, Sweden ("**PowerTender**"), collects, uses, discloses, stores and otherwise process personal data.
- 1.2 We respect your right to privacy, and we are committed to comply with applicable data protection rules and to safeguard your rights. We want to make sure that you are aware of what types of information we collect or obtain from you via the website, how this information is used and how we protect it.
- 1.3 By using this website, or (where applicable) by submitting an application for joining PowerTender, using our services or subscribing to our newsletters, you agree to this Privacy Policy. However, please note that this Privacy Policy only contains general information about PowerTender's collection and processing of personal data when you are browsing through PowerTender's website. If you submit your personal data to us for any reason, for example, if you submit an application to publish an ad and create an account or subscribe to our newsletters, you will be provided with more specific information about our use of your personal data, including:
- what personal information we collect, for what purpose and through which technical means;
 - to whom your personal data is disclosed; and
 - how long your personal data will be retained.

2 WHAT TYPES OF PERSONAL DATA DO WE PROCESS?

- 2.1 Personal data means all types of information which can, directly or indirectly, be used to identify a living physical person ("**Personal Data**").
- 2.2 PowerTender collects and processes Personal Data about you when you visit our website, including
- (i) information about how you in particular use the website;
 - (ii) details of the queries you make;
 - (iii) content you post, upload and/or contributes to the website;
 - (iv) technical data, which may include your URL, IP address, unique device ID, network and computer performance, browser type, language and identifying information and operating system; and
 - (v) location information.
- 2.3 If You create an account or are otherwise required to register in order to use our services or complete an online application form, PowerTender may collect Personal Data, such as name, e-mail address, country of residence and other

information which you voluntarily submit to PowerTender. In each such case, you will also be provided with more detailed information, as exemplified above, about our use of your Personal Data in such case.

3 WHY DO WE PROCESS YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

3.1 PowerTender collects Personal Data relating to you for the following reasons:

- (i) to provide, personalise and improve your experience with the website and our services;
- (ii) to enable integration with third party services;
- (iii) to analyse your use of the website and our services in order for us to develop and improve the website and the services as well as developing new services and products;
- (iv) to ensure the technical functioning of the website and the services;
- (v) to market ourselves and our services (provided however, that you will always have the right to opt-out of any marketing messages from us); and
- (vi) to fulfil requirements by law.

4 FOR HOW LONG DO WE STORE YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

Your Personal Data is stored only for as long as there is a need to keep the data in order to fulfil the purposes for which the data was collected in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

The Personal Data will be deleted if:

1. the purpose of collection and use of Personal Data has been achieved;
2. the provision of the relevant service is discontinued by PowerTender; or
3. you withdraw your consent (if applicable) to the collection of Personal Data by contacting us (for contact information, please see Section 8 below).

5 HOW MAY THE DATA BE SHARED?

5.1 PowerTender will not sell, trade or lease your Personal Data to third parties. However, PowerTender may share Personal Data with our trusted subcontractors (including Internet service providers) in order to provide you with our services. They may need access to the Personal Data in their assignment for us, but they will not be allowed to use the Personal Data for any other purpose.

5.2 Unless otherwise set forth in any specific information regarding our processing of your personal data, PowerTender will not transfer your Personal Data to any country outside the EEA.

5.3 Personal Data may be disclosed by PowerTender to comply with legal requirements or other requirements from official authorities, in order to safeguard PowerTender's legal interests or to detect, prevent, or draw attention to frauds or other safety or technical problems.

6 PROTECTION OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

You should always feel secure when you provide your Personal Data to us. We have employed a wide range of security measures to help protect your Personal Data against undue access, modification and deletion.

We protect your Personal Data using commercially reasonable safeguards to prevent loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, and destruction. These measures include data encryption, firewalls, automatic timeouts and one-time access links that expires within hours. Furthermore, our servers are protected by SSL certificates issued by one of the top-ranking Certification Authorities. Therefore, you can rest assure that your Personal Data is in safe hands.

7 YOUR RIGHTS

Withdrawal of consent

You will always have the option of letting us know if you no longer agree to the collection, use and transfer of your Personal Data according to this Privacy Policy and (if applicable) any specific privacy notice governing our use of your personal information in a specific case. In connection thereto, you will also have the right to request that we erase all of your Personal Data.

Corrections, additions or erasure

You are always entitled to access your Personal Data for viewing, and to request that we correct or update your Personal Data, or erase certain of your Personal Data.

Restriction of use and data portability

Under certain circumstances, you may request that PowerTender restricts the use of your Personal Data. You also have the right to have your Personal Data resubmitted to you, in a structured and accessible format, for transfer to another user/processor.

Requests and Complaints

If you wish to exercise any of the abovementioned rights or if you have any questions regarding Personal Data held by us or this online Privacy Policy, please do not hesitate to contact us (for contact information, please see section 8 below).

Should you be dissatisfied with our processing of your Personal Data, please let us know, and we will do our best to meet your complaints. Your integrity is very important to us, and we always strive to protect and secure your Personal Data in the best possible way. Should we nevertheless, in your opinion, fail in this ambition, please note that you are also entitled to lodge a complaint with the Swedish Data Protection Authority (Sw. Datainspektionen), or such other authority as may be determined in the future.
